### Requirements for Scholarship Eligibility

- Student/family must be Foundation for the Fine Arts members for at least 2 years.
- Student must be a graduating senior.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of 85%.
- Student must have participated in a Fine Arts discipline for at least 2 years.
- Student must be or have been enrolled/participated in a Fine Arts class or discipline at Centennial during the 2020-2021 school year.
- Student must be attending college after graduation.

### Instructions for Scholarship Application

1. Request recommendation from a Fine Arts teacher. Inform your teacher of the application deadline. Teachers will have a copy of the recommendation forms to submit. Teachers may return to you in a sealed envelope or placed in our scholarship folder in the front office.
2. Submit proof of college/secondary school admission (copy of admission letter, etc.). If the admission letter has not yet been received at the time of submission, note it on the application.
3. Complete and submit the Academic and Extracurricular Information on the following pages. Information may be typed, or neatly printed and additional pages may be added.
4. The final question/essay *"How has participation in the Fine Arts through your high school years influenced the person you are today? Do you plan to continue fine arts beyond high school and if so, how?"* Essay must be typed with a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words. In the event of applications with similar qualifications, the essay will be the deciding factor.
5. Submit the entire scholarship package (items 1, 2, 3, and 4) in an envelope labeled "2021 FFA Scholarship Application" by **4:00 pm on Monday, April 19, 2021. Applications may be submitted in one of three ways and late applications will not be considered:**
  1. Turned into the front office at Centennial High School to be placed in our FFA folder.
