Requirements for Scholarship Eligibility

- Student/family must be Foundation for the Fine Arts members for at least 2 years.
- Student must be a graduating senior.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of 85%.
- Student must have participated in a Fine Arts discipline for at least 2 years.
- Student must be or have been enrolled/participated in a Fine Arts class or discipline at Centennial during the 2019-2020 school year.

Instructions for Scholarship Application

1. Request recommendation from a Fine Arts teacher. (Teacher should be aware of application deadline)
2. Submit proof of college/secondary school admission (copy of admission letter, etc.). If the admission letter has not yet been received at the time of submission, note it on the application.
3. Complete and submit the Academic Information on the following page. Information may be typed or neatly printed additional pages may be added.
4. Write and submit an essay on the following topic: *Describe your goals, your field of study, and why you are applying for this scholarship.* The essay must be typed with a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words. In the event of applications with similar qualifications, the essay will be the deciding factor.
5. Submit the entire scholarship package (items 1, 2, 3, and 4) in an envelope labeled "2020 FFA Scholarship Application" to the front office by **4:00 pm on Friday, April 17, 2020.**

The scholarship committee will review the materials blindly and objectively, assigning point values based on the criteria noted above.
